3.1. Course Objectives	The objective of the course "Français 1" is providing basic knowledge, vocabulary and language structures for understanding basic concepts in everyday and business communication in French. Particular attention is focused on the reading and understanding of the less demanding texts and understanding of short media forms – commercials, newspaper headlines and articles. The aim is for students, in written and verbal form, to quickly apply what they have learned about basic communication in French. Students learn about and analyse the most important media of the French-speaking area.
